### 46 Cases

in Greater Columbus





All **46 children were unvaccinated** for measles, with 19 hospitalized (as of 12/01/22)

## **Complications of Measles**

#### **Common:**

- Ear infections
- Diarrhea

#### **Serious:**

- Pneumonia is the #1 cause of pediatric measles-related deaths
- Encephalitis (inflammation of the brain)
- Measles infections during pregnancy may also cause miscarriage, stillbirth, low birth weight, and an increased risk of preterm delivery

## What are the symptoms?

- Red rash that starts on head and spreads down
- High fever
- Red or watery eyes
- Cough
- Runny nose
- Sore throat
