Students at home enrolled and engaged in our online learning platform. Must remain enrolled 9 weeks at a time.

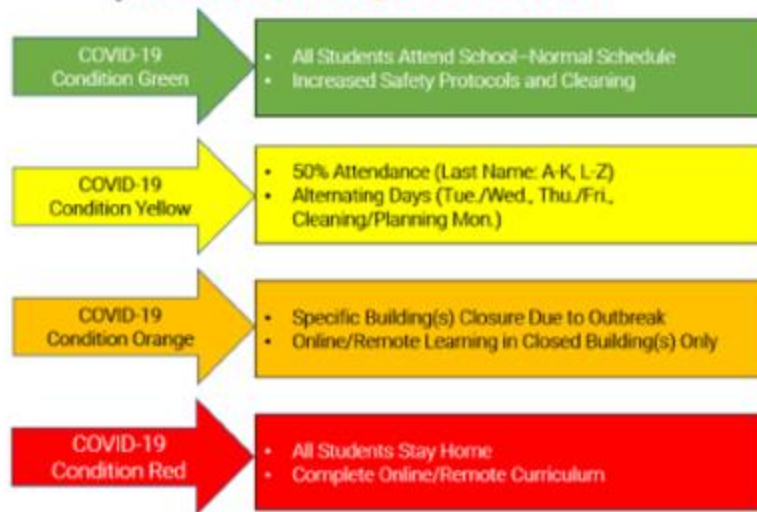
Mask/Facial Covering Policy:
