OPERATING SCENARIOS FOR FACE-TO-FACE INSTRUCTION

GREEN - Five days (Monday through Friday) of face-to-face instruction in buildings as traditional as possible while taking all precautions for our staff and students.

YELLOW - Students divided into two groups and attending in person for face-to-face instruction 2 days a week and learning from home 3 days a week.

RED - Remote learning for all students at home.

Our plan is to open the school year on the Green level. However, due to possible changes/directives from the Governor and the Belmont County Health Department, we may need to change this decision. This has been, and continues to be, a very difficult process due to so many variables. We also understand that it has created a stressful situation for parents and students. We greatly appreciate your patience as we continue to make decisions with your student's best interests in mind.
